

DOH Wellness Reporting Considerations for CHSP Providers



Under the new contracts, all CHSP funded providers are required to report annually on their progress in implementing the wellness and reablement approach in their work with clients. The first report is due 31 October 2018.



This 3 hour workshop will use the Departmental reporting template (due to be released by end of August) as its base and will explore what types of evidence providers can collect and use to report on their progress and achievements.

At the end of the workshop, participants will:

- understand what is meant by the terms person centred practice, wellness, reablement and short-term restorative care
- know what service providers need to do to comprehensively embed wellness and reablement approaches within their CHSP funded projects
- be able to identify existing evidence of their progress in implementing wellness and reablement approaches
- be able to develop a list of, and implement, other actions to further embed wellness and reablement approaches in their community care practice.
