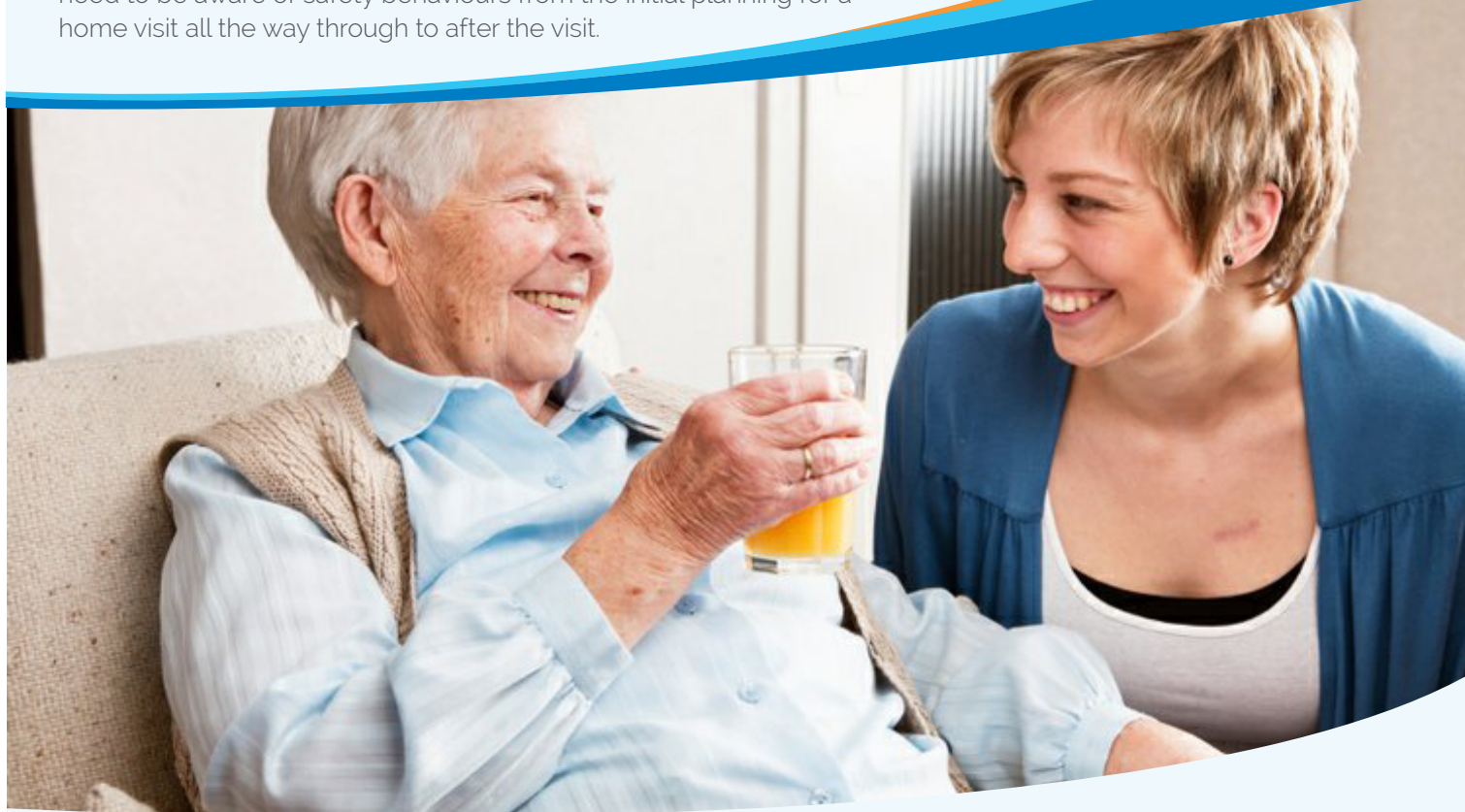


# SAFE HOME VISITING
