# **Priority of Access**

CHSP service volunteers in the Local Government areas of Canterbury Bankstown and Inner West will be given registration priority.

# **Payment**

STARS will send an invoice for the training to the organisation for payment within two weeks.

# Confirmation

Confirmation of registration will be by phone or email. When a training session is fully booked a waiting list will be created.

### Cancellations

# **Transfers**
