## Lakemba Competition

### Guidelines



The 2018 Cleanest Street in Lakemba Awards will recognise achievements in the following categories:

- Cleanest street; and
- Good neighbour, (an award given to the highest percentage of participants on a single street).

Streets will be judged on the:

- Level they are litter free;
- Lack of illegally dumped household goods; and
- Tidiness of the nature strip.

#### Terms and conditions

Please read the following conditions to ensure your entry is submitted correctly.

#### For all entrants

1. Complete the entry form and lodge it by 30 September 2018.
2. Only one entry form can be completed per household.
3. Your street address on the entry form will be the one you are entering in the competition.
4. Streets entered must be in the official municipal boundary of Lakemba.
5. Environment@Lakemba holds the rights to decline entry forms if they are incomplete, out of area or do not correspond to the entrant's home address.
6. Entries will be judged by Council officers, using audit data to decide the winners of each category.
7. A minimum number of entries per category have been set. Environment@Lakemba has the right to not proceed with that category should there be insufficient entries.
8. Winners will be presented with their awards at Carols in the Park on 2 December 2018, and recognised in the Canterbury City Community Centre's publication after the presentation.
9. Prizes will be awarded to the group of entrants named on the entry forms for a particular street. Additional certificates will be available on request.
10. Environment@Lakemba reserves the right to select or change the prize that will be awarded to winners and finalists.

#### Submission deadlines

11. All entries must be received by 4pm Sunday 30 September 2018 to be valid. Any entries received after this time will not be accepted.
12. Entries can be submitted:

  - b. By post to PO Box 66, Lakemba 2195; or
  - c. In person at Canterbury City Community Centre, 130 Railway Parade, Lakemba.
13. Entries will be assisted by Environment@Lakemba with resources and information provided to support clean-up efforts and encourage others in their street to join in.
14. Entrants will need to collect cleaning resources and information from Canterbury City Community Centre.
15. Individual entries from a street will be contacted by Canterbury City Community Centre to see if they would like to join together to keep their street clean. Permission will be sought from individuals before sharing any contact details.
